SAFE DISPOSAL OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION IN EL PASO COUNTY



BACKGROUND

Getting rid of old or unused meds using a safe disposal box or a take back event is the best way to ensure they won't be misused or stolen. Colorado has a program with more than 100 secure take back boxes at pharmacies and law enforcement agencies. Many pharmacy chains are committed to safe disposal as well, and have take back boxes conveniently placed inside the pharmacy. You also can go to National Prescription Drug Take Back Day, which takes place the last Saturday of April and October. Local police departments also sponsor take back days. Meds collected this way are securely disposed of, usually by incineration. Nearly 224,000 Coloradans misuse prescription medication every year. You can be part of the solution by taking stock of the unused medication in your home and utilizing safe disposal kiosks in your community.

WHAT IS ACCEPTED

- Prescription medications, including prescribed controlled substances (DEA Schedule II–V)
- Over-the-counter medications
- Liquid medications (small amounts in original, non-leaking containers)
- Medicated patches (Used Fentanyl and Duragesic® patches are extremely hazardous. They may be folded in half, sticky-side together, and flushed down the toilet.)
- Medication samples
- Medicated ointments
- Vitamins
- Pet medications
- Unused drug injection cartridges, e.g. unused EpiPens® and insulin pens (must be unused with needle still protected inside)
- Unused inhaler canisters, e.g. Advair®, Spiriva®, ProAir® and Ventolin® (must be unused, no empty canisters or unneeded plastic holders/mouth pieces)
