



The Pikes Peak Continuum of Care is preparing for the 2023 Point-in-Time (PIT) Count and we need your help!

The 2023 PIT count is a survey of people experiencing homelessness in Colorado Springs/El Paso County, which asks where people slept the night of Sunday, January 22nd into Monday January 23rd, 2023.
